# G

**(1) The Bayanihan Center for Rural Development (BCRD)**  
**Location: Bolaney, Alaminos City**

The facility is the only training center in Western Pangasinan. It is located at Bolaney, Alaminos City, Pangasinan, situated in a 0.5 hectare government lot. It is a 2-storey concrete building that houses a Modern training Hall with a 50 person capacity, a Dormitory for the participants, Mini Conference Room, a Library, a Canteen and Offices.

**(2) Pangasinan Industrial Park II (Economic-Zone)**  
**Location: Alos, Alaminos City & Tagudin, Mabini**

The Pangasinan Industrial Park II located in Barangay Alos, Alaminos City and Barangay Tagudin, Mabini, Pangasinan covers an area of 26.50 hectares. It is declared as special Economic Zone thru Presidential Proclamation No. 1226 issued on May 22, 1998. The facility can cater for the establishment of light to medium scale, non-pollute industries. Formerly the car assembly plant of PROTON Malaysia; it is the proposed site for the Hundred Islands International Airport.

**(3) Agricultural Techno-Demo-Farm**  
**Location: Tangarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan**

The facility is a show window of the latest advancements and technological breakthroughs in agriculture. The establishment of this 5-hectare Agriculture Techno-Demo-Farm was conceptualized by the City Government in its bid to be the "Green City in the Philippines".

**(4) Goat Commercialization Program**  
**Location: Tangarang, Alaminos City, Pangasinan**

Thru a partnership with Mr. Manuel Volante, the project showcases the application of the Farmers Livestock School on Integrated Goat Management (FLS-IGM) being promoted by the City Government.

**(5) Material Recovery Facility**  
**Location: Bisocol, Alaminos City, Pangasinan**

The facility was established in response to the provision of R.A. 9003 otherwise known as the Solid Waste Management Act. Currently produces organic fertilizer out of the biodegradable waste collected by the City.

**(6) Don Gonzalo Montemayor Wharf**  
**Location: Brgy. Lucap, Alaminos City**

The Dr. Gonzalo Montemayor Wharf, commonly referred to as "Lucap Wharf", is the primary jump-off point of tourists that visits the Hundred Islands National Park. It was named after Dr. Montemayor, the then Pangasinan Health Officer in 1937 who was directed to manage the Hundred Islands by President Manuel L. Quezon.

# E

**(7) Quezon Islands**  
**Location: Hundred Islands, Alaminos City, Pangasinan**

It is the largest among the 123 islands that comprises the Hundred Islands National Park. A facility includes pavilion, nipa huts, dining, cooking areas and restrooms that assure comfort. Lots of fun activities can be done such as lying in the white sand, snorkeling, taking in the fresh salty breeze, savoring the delectable seafood and swim to your heart's delight.
